#### Work this week of June 1<sup>st</sup>:

Contractor has completed the mainline sanitary sewer and water main work on North Circle Drive up to the East Circle Drive connection. What remains for utility work are water and sanitary sewer services, and storm sewer.

The grading crew will have completed the roadbed preparation in the cul-de-sac and capped the sand section with gravel so the property owners can access their drives again for the weekend.

#### Week of June 7th:

Beginning on Monday, the main utility crew will begin installing the storm sewer from the golf course to the street and installing drainage structures at the intersection. They will progress to the east and up the hill with storm sewer during the week.

A 2<sup>nd</sup> utility crew is expected to move in on Tuesday or Wednesday to work on sanitary sewer and water services on North Circle Drive where the mainline work was recently completed. Utility services should be complete or nearly complete by the end of the week.

The road grading crew will continue working on the cul-de-sac and then following up behind the utility crews with subcutting the roadbed, placing fabric, sand, and gravel to start getting the area ready for curb placement in the near future.

#### Week of June 14th:

Utility work (storm sewer and services) on North Circle Drive should be completed with the focus on preparing the roadbed all the way to East Circle Drive and preparing the street for curb.

The contractor will be looking to possibly begin removals on West Circle Drive in preparation of beginning utility work (water main and storm sewer) on West Circle Drive.
