### 2023 CITY-WIDE CLEAN-UP

The annual city-wide spring clean-up will be held on <u>Saturday, May 13 from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.</u> at <u>Memorial Park</u> – 500 5th St. SE.

Please follow the map below. <u>Traffic will enter on</u> the East side of Memorial Park from 5<sup>th</sup> St SE. Please follow the signage to the South side of Memorial Field. All traffic will then exit onto Oak Ave SE from  $2^{nd}$  St SE.



The city **WILL NOT** accept household hazardous waste – paint, solvents, oils, lubricants, or any other type of chemical substance, batteries of any kind, containers containing any liquid, tires, yard waste, branches, leaves, etc.

Residents will need to bring their items to the collection location and there will be a charge in accordance with the fee schedule below.

Large appliances – washing machines, dryers, water heaters, stoves, etc. will be collected **AT THE CURB**. If you have such items, **you must pre-pay and get a ticket from City Hall by** <u>Wednesday May 10<sup>th</sup> at</u> <u>4:00 p.m.</u>

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## CONSUMER CONFIDENCE REPORT

## GOLF CARTS, ATV'S, AND SIDE-BY-SIDES

Golf carts, ATV's and side-by-sides are an economical and inexpensive way to get around town in the summer, and many residents have opted for this mode of transportation.

Montgomery City Code specifically allows these types of vehicles to operate on city streets as long as they are properly licensed and operated in accordance with the Code. This includes the following:

- Operator's must be **16 years** of age or older.
- Anyone under 18 on an ATV or side-by-side must wear an approved DOT helmet.
- Only the number of passengers the device is designed for can be on/in the vehicle and all passengers must be on a seat designed for sitting. No standing on the back of a golf cart or carrying a child on one's lap.

There are other vehicles that are not permitted to be operated on City streets. These include, but are not limited to mini-bikes, "pocket" bikes, go-carts, home-made vehicles, dirt-bikes, lawnmowers, etc. Essentially, if the vehicle cannot be licensed by the State of Minnesota for operation on a public street, and it is not a golf cart, ATV, or Utility Task Vehicle (Side-by-side), it cannot be operated on any public street or alley.

If you need a license for your special use vehicle, you can obtain an application at City Hall or download the form from the City's website. Applications must be brought to the Montgomery Police Department or City Hall during normal business hours, along with a current copy of insurance information. <u>The fee for the license is \$20 and</u> <u>must be renewed every calendar year.</u>
