2024 Citywide Clean-Up

The annual city-wide spring clean-up will be held on **Saturday, May 11 from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.** at **Memorial Park** – 500 5th St. SE.

Please follow the map below. **Traffic will enter on the East side of Memorial Park from 5th St SE.** Please follow the signage to the South side of Memorial Field. All traffic will then exit onto Oak Ave SE from 2nd St SE.



The city **WILL NOT** accept household hazardous waste – paint, solvents, oils, lubricants, or any other type of chemical substance, batteries of any kind, containers containing any liquid, tires, yard waste, branches, leaves, etc.

Residents will need to bring their items to the collection location and there will be a charge in accordance with the fee schedule below.

Large appliances – washing machines, dryers, water heaters, stoves, etc. will be collected **AT THE CURB**. If you have such items, **you must pre-pay and get a ticket from City Hall by Wednesday May 8th at 4:00 p.m.**

Acceptable items are:

Furniture – beds, couches, chairs, tables, etc
Lawn furniture
Scrap metal
Remodeling materials in small amounts
Other miscellaneous junk

WE CANNOT ACCEPT: Business waste, Commercial bulbs; used oil or filters; explosives or ammunition.
