Work this week of May 24th:

As we are writing this update, on Thursday 5/27, it is raining. BCM is intending to work on Friday if conditions allow. The contractor has completed all the utility work in the cul-de-sac and through the West Circle Drive intersection. The utility crew is continuing with the sanitary sewer main work on North Circle Drive.

The grading crew has started subcutting the cul-de-sac to prepare for placement of fabric, sand, drain tile, and aggregate base.

Week of June 1st:

Monday, 5/31 is a holiday and the contractor will not be working in observance of Memorial Day. Utility work will continue with the installation of sanitary sewer main and services heading up the hill and then will finish with water main.

The grading crew will be looking to complete the street section construction in preparation for concrete curb at a later date.

The contractor may begin installing the storm sewer from North Circle Drive to the Golf Course and installing catch basins and manholes in the street.

Week of June 7th:

During the week the utility crew will continue working on North Circle Drive on storm sewer, and then looking to continue east with main line sanitary sewer, water main, and services.
