Centennial Family Awards Program



The Centennial Family Awards Program honors families who have lived in the Montgomery area continuously for 100 years or more. The Montgomery area includes the City of Montgomery, or a rural Montgomery postal address. The awards will be presented each January at the Montgomery Historical Society's annual meeting. Nominees are accepted at any time. Nominations received after November 15 will be considered for a subsequent year.

Application Process

Submissions are accepted at any time during the year. Nominations received after November 15 will be considered for a subsequent year. Up to three families are honored each January at our annual meeting.

The application fee is \$25.00. Nominees must be a member of the Montgomery Historical Society. (Annual memberships are \$15 for individuals and \$25 for families.) For questions, please send an email to montymnhistory@gmail.com or contact a member of the board.
